Policy detail	<ol> <li>The Learning Connexion has adopted the following Animals on Campus policy.</li> <li>The goal of the Animals on Campus Policy is to balance the overriding purpose of TLC and its students with the needs of animal owners and their pets/support dogs. The school's purpose is education although we recognise that animals/pets, when appropriately managed, can contribute to psychological well-being and creativity.</li> <li>Animals must be registered with our Admissions team - name of animal and owner, and a description of the animal needs to be provided so that the animal and owner are easily identified.</li> <li>Animal owners are responsible for the behaviour of their pets/support dogs.</li> <li>Animal owners must clean up after their pets/support dogs - owners should use poop bags and dispose of these appropriately.</li> <li>Dogs must be on a lead at all times. If they need a run, they are to be taken off-site. If dogs are in a studio they must be tied up in a suitable place where they will not be tripped over, or in the way of students or staff.</li> <li>Animal owners must provide water bowls and any other necessary utensils for their pets/support dogs and not use bowls from the kitchen and communal areas.</li> <li>Animals may not be allowed on TLC furniture.</li> <li>It is the responsibility of the owner to check whether their pet is acceptable to others using a studio/office and if there are requests that the pet not be in the studio/office, then this must be abided by. NB: As support dogs are required to remain by their owner this point does not apply, unless the support dog is in any way not well behaved.</li> <li>It is the owner's responsibility to ensure their pet/support dog. It is now on a pool health and has no communicable diseases, e.g. fleas.</li> <li>No animals are to be at any meetings, unless it is a support dog.</li> <li>Local body regulations apply in all cases.</li> <li>The grounds of TLC's Taita campus are under the jurisdiction of the TL</li></ol>

	maintenance staff to act on its behalf in regard to the
	behaviour of animals.
	Owners must sign the TLC 'Animal / Pet Registration' form, and abide by the Animals on Campus Policy if they wish to bring their pets/support dogs to TLC. Failure to observe the Animals on Campus policy will trigger an investigation on behalf of the Managing Director who may require one of the following options:
	<ul><li>a. The animal to be kept away from the campus permanently</li><li>b. The animal to be kept away for a defined period at the end of which the situation will be reviewed</li></ul>
	A review will take into account any change which reasonably indicates that it is acceptable for the animal to be 're-registered'. If there has been no change, the Managing Director will choose option 'a' or 'b'.
